To improve student achievement in reading.	<p>2022: For those enrolled in year 4 in 2022, 6/17 maintained or achieved SEA in PAT reading. Target was 59%, 35% was achieved.</p> <p>2023: For those enrolled in year 4 in 2022 (current year 5's): - 75% (12/16) will maintain or achieve SEA in PAT reading assigned year level test (with an SEA). - 50% (9/18) will maintain or achieve SEA in NAPLAN reading.</p> <p>2024: For those enrolled in year 4 in 2022 (current year 6's), 87.5% (14/16) will maintain or achieve SEA in PAT reading at their assigned year level test.</p>	If we focus on analysing student data and embedding responsive evidence-based practice, with a focus on reading comprehension, then we will raise achievement data in PAT Reading and NAPLAN.	<p>Students will define predicting, visualising, making connections and summarising.</p> <p>Using a variety of text types, students will make predictions and make text-self, text-text, text-world connections. Students will answer literal, inferential and evaluative questions in fiction and non-fiction texts.</p> <p>Students will identify the purpose of texts (inform, entertain, persuade, procedural)</p> <p>Students will use contextual clues to identify the intended audience of texts. Students will be able to articulate their individual reading goals.</p>
