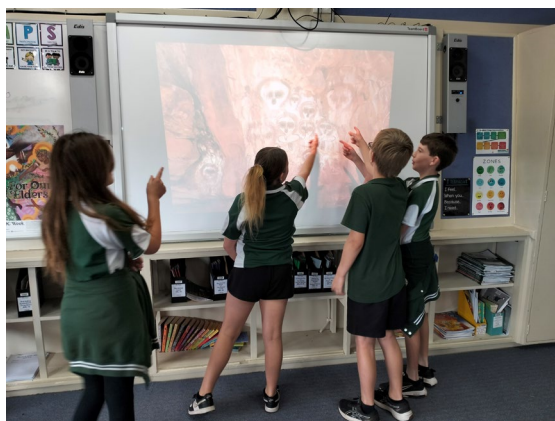

In Music, students explored how music is different across cultures. They also explored how First Nation Australians use music to communicate their connection to country.

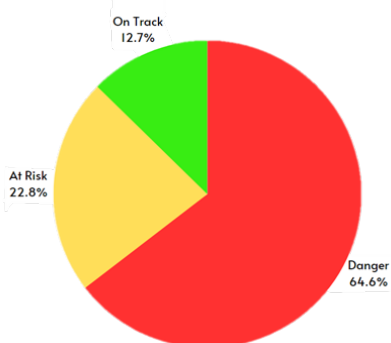




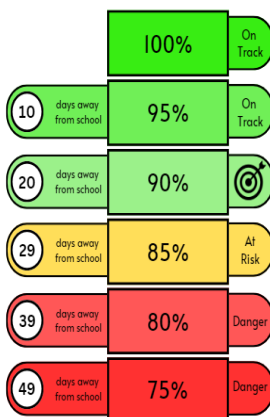
Attendance
